



Procedure

1. Open a Web Browser, and input printers IP address in the URL field. Click on login on the top right of the screen Login with "admin" and Password "123456"




Click on "Registration" → "Address Book" → "Shared Setting"




3. On the Primary MFD under "Shared Address Book" select "Enable (Primary)" from the pull down menu and "Save" This MFD is now the primary device and all secondary MFD's will synchronise their Address Book from this source




- 4. On the Primary MFD under "Shared Address Book" select "Enable (Primary)" from the pull down menu and "Save"
- 5. In the same area as your Primary Shared on your 2nd MFD, Enable (Secondary) then save



6. Under the "Primary MFP Setting" add the IP Address for the Secondary MFD




7. Then click on "Sync All". This will put a tick next to Network address of the device you are synching with


